Lesson discussion material will be rotated weekly amongst the various Target Groups (Adult Women, Adult Men, Young Adult, Youth) in an effort to include all ages in this lesson series.

The Overview is merely a brief discussion of the bible lesson. In order to gain a better understanding of the lesson, it is recommended that, prior to each lesson, participants read through the **Lesson Text**, **Related Scriptures**, **Daily Bible Reading** scriptures (each day), try to answer the **Discussion Questions**, and make a note of any additional questions you may have. Prayer and meditation are always essential in gaining a better understanding of God's Word and its relevance to your life and situation.

August 2022 UNIT III: Faithful to Heal

All lessons this month will focus on miraculous healings. The first two weeks cover the healing ministries of Jesus Christ that demonstrated the power of God. The last two weeks show how God used His followers to help bring others into the family of God.

WEEK 1-Jesus Heals Two Demonics: This lesson focuses on Jesus' authority over both the natural and the spiritual realm

WEEK 2- A Lamed Man Healed: This lesson shows how God gives His people opportunities to serve and supplies the power needed

WEEK 3- Ananias Heals Saul: This lesson shows how God called and sent Ananias to restore Saul's sight and to further instruct Saul on what to do for the Lord

WEEK 4- Miracles on Malta: This lesson shows how God worked healings through Paul and used him to reach others

GOLDEN TEXT: "And, behold, they cried out, saying, What have we to do with thee, Jesus, thou Son of God? Art thou come hither to torment us before the time?" (Matthew 8:29)

TARGET AGE GROUP: This week's discussion is taken from the **Adult Bible Class** book.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Why were storms on the Sea of Galilee quite common?
- 2. Why do you think Jesus could sleep through a violent storm?
- 3. Because of their fear, what kind of faith did the Lord say the disciples had?
- 4. How was the miracle of stilling the storm different from some of Jesus' other miracles?
- 5. What are some of the differences in the three Gospel accounts of the demon possession that Jesus and the disciples encountered?
- 6. How could the demons recognize Christ?
- 7. What else did the demons know besides Jesus' identity?
- 8. Why did the demons want to go into the herd of swine?
- 9. Why do you think the people wanted Jesus to leave?
- 10. What did the former demoniac want to do?

- 4. What made the transformation of the lame man's situation truly amazing?
- 5. How did people in the temple complex respond to the miracle?
- 6. How did Peter take advantage of the situation?
- 7. To what did Peter attribute the miracle?

- 6. What three things about Saul did the Lord tell Ananias?
- 7. How did Ananias minister to Saul?
- 8. What did Saul's baptism declare publicly?
- 9. How did Saul prove himself to be Christ's disciple?

- 4. Why did they soon afterward conclude he was a god?
- 5. What did Publius do for the voyagers?
- 6. What unexpected benefit did Publius' hospitality have for him?
- 7. When Paul prayed for the healing of Publius' father, what did this demonstrate to others?
- 8. Why did the islanders go to Paul to be healed and not he to them?
- 9. Why is it safe to surmise that Paul's ministry on Malta included more than just healing?
- 10. How did the Maltese show their thanks when the travelers left?
