January 2023 UNIT II:

All lessons this month will examine the great blessings of the saving gospel message WEEK 1-Blessing of Reconciliation: This lesson looks at our reconciliation with God through Jesus Christ.

- 2. Why is it wrong to "glory in appearance" (II Corinthians 5:12)?
- 3. What are some possible reasons some might have thought Paul was mad?
- 4. What was the primary motivation for Paul to serve Christ?
- 5. Because Christ "died for all" (vs. 15), how should we live?
- 6. What does being "in Christ" (v. 17) mean for us?
- 7. What ministry was given to Paul?
- 8. What does "not imputing their trespasses" (v. 19) mean?
- 9. How can we be "ambassadors for Christ" (vs. 20)?
- 10. How did Christ become "sin for us" (vs. 21)? What results because of His sacrifice?

- 6. How is faith related to works?
- 7. What danger did Paul express through the proverb about leaven?
- 8. Of what was Paul confident regarding the Galatian believers?
- 9. How does faith relate to the fact that love fulfills the law?
- 10. What is walking "in the Spirit" (vs. 16)? What results from it?

- 6. How can a church of diverse elements present a unified witness?
- 7. Is it easy for Christians to rejoice and sympathize with each other? Explain
- 8. I Paul's list of spiritual gifts, which ones did he rank higher? Why?
- 9. How was Paul's ranking of gifts a rebuke to the Corinthians?
- 10. What was Paul's advice to believers at the end of this passage?
