Lesson discussion material will be rotated weekly amongst the various Target Groups (Junior, Primary, and Beginner classes) in an effort to include all ages in this lesson series.

The Overview is merely a brief discussion of the bible lesson. In order to gain a better understanding of the lesson, it is recommended that, prior to each lesson, participants read through the **Lesson Text**, **Related Scriptures**, **Daily Bible Reading** scriptures (each day), try to answer the **Review Questions**, and make a note of any additional questions you may have. Prayer and meditation are always essential in gaining a better understanding of God's Word and its relevance to your life and situation.

October 2022 UNIT II: Obedience In Worship

All lessons this month will come from the books of Exodus and Leviticus and will focus on obedience that honors God through worship.

- WEEK 1-Obedience in Worshipping God Alone: God declares His underlying requirements
- **WEEK 2- Obedience In Building the Tabernacle:** God provides instructions on building a place for His holiness to reside safely among His people
- **WEEK 3- Obedience on the Day of Atonement:** God shows His people how their sinfulness would be covered
- WEEK 4- Obedience In Offerings: God teaches His people to honor His holiness through their offerings
- **WEEK 5- Obedience In Feasts:** God ordains festivals in which His people would remember His goodness to them and rejoice before Him
